Holy Family Home is recruiting a Foot Care Nurse to provide services to residents who live on various units, including the special needs units.

The Foot Care Nurse shall provide regular foot care (approximately every 6-8 weeks) to residents who are assessed by their Unit Nurse as needing this specialized care.

Authorization for care shall be obtained from the Unit Nurse or Social Worker, by the resident if competent, and /or by the resident's substitute decision-maker before treatment can be undertaken. Treatment shall be provided to the resident on an ongoing basis unless otherwise specified on the consent form.

The Foot Care Nurse will enter into a contract with Holy Family Home. A signed copy of the contract and confirmation of successfully completed Advanced Foot Care Nurse course must be submitted to the Director of Care and Human Resources personnel prior to providing service to residents.

As foot care is a non-insured benefit to residents, substitute decision-makers are responsible for payment, which can be reimbursed through resident trust accounts or directly from residents or substitute decision-makers.

The Foot Care Nurse shall be responsible for equipment maintenance, cleaning and sterilization. Gloves and all equipment and supplies shall be the responsibility of the Foot Care Nurse (excluding towels).
