I am hoping this letter finds you well and you are enjoying the extended daylight hours and warmer weather that Mother Nature has provided to you over the last several weeks.

Today is my first letter to you all that is not about outbreaks. I am happy to share Holy Family Home is presently outbreak free. I did want to share that Manitoba Health did announce residents in long-term care would be eligible for the spring COVID 19 vaccines starting in May and June 2025. Nursing will be contacting you in the near future to obtain your consent.

As some of you may know, Holy Family Home is undergoing a fire and life safety project or sprinkler project on the main floor and the basement of the B building. This past week we did have a hoarding wall erected on the main floor just past the front entrance of Holy Family Home. This hoarding wall is to provide protection to the residents, family and staff from the construction area, which will include preventing exposure to debris, dust or fumes. The plan is for sprinkler piping and sprinkler heads to be installed in the B building, on the entire main floor of Holy Family Home as well as the entire A Building. The exact timeline for the stages of the installation is not finalized, so more information will be shared as the stages progress.
